The requirements below outline the most common credentials that educators earn to work in School Support Personnel settings.



Professional Educator License (PEL) Requirements

Option 1

PEL + School Support
Personnel endorsement
(Prekindergarten-12 or Prekindergarten-Age 22)

Short-Term Approval (STA) Requirements

Option 1

STA — School Support Personnel Areas (Prekindergarten-Age 22)

- Master's degree in content area (bachelor's degree for School Nurse)
- Professional Certification from IDFPR or National Certification in the content area
- A passing score on the applicable School Support Personnel content test

These approvals are temporary credentials that allow an educator to immediately begin teaching while working toward full licensure requirements.
