

Pathways to Licensure: School Support Personnel



Are you looking to fill a vacant School Support Personnel position in your school? You may have an educator in your school or district who is already qualified to fill the position! The requirements below outline the most common credentials that educators earn to work in School Support Personnel settings.

Professional Educator License (PEL) Requirements

Option 1

PEL + School Support
Personnel endorsement
(Prekindergarten-12 or Prekindergarten-Age 22)

Short-Term Approval (STA) Requirements

Option 1

STA – School Support Personnel Areas
(Prekindergarten-Age 22)

- Master's degree in content area (bachelor's degree for School Nurse)
- Professional Certification from IDFPR or National Certification in the content area
- A passing score on the applicable School Support Personnel content test

These approvals are temporary credentials that allow an educator to immediately begin teaching while working toward full licensure requirements.
